Sashes for teams to 6th Place.

Individual Winner and Runner Up in each level will receive a sash and prize.

Ribbons 1-6<sup>th</sup> in each event.

#### **Events**

**Event 1** - Games – Bending Race

Event 2 - Games - Mug Race

**Event 3** – Showjumping – Two Phase

Event 4 – Showjumping – Art 238.2.1

Event 5 – Rider

Event 6 – Handler

**Event 7** – Pleasure Mount

Event 8 – Ridden Mount under 12 hands

Event 9 - Ridden Mount 12hands and under 14 hands

Event 10 – Ridden Mount 14 hands and under 15 hands

Event 11 – Ridden Mount over 15 hands

**Event 12** - Obstacle Course

Event 13 – Horse or Pony any height (led riders only)

### All entrants compete in 6 events.

\*Events 1&2 will be run against the clock, participants can have up to 2 turns at each event with the best time used. The riders best time will be used in team scores but placings will be awarded to sixth for all individual games. Competitors will compete in Year levels.

\*Events 3 & 4 will be run at showjumping heights 40cm, 60cm, 80cm, 90cm, 1m, 1.10m & 1.20m. Competitors must nominate which height they will compete in – no transferring to alternate heights

will be permitted on the day. The lowest height for secondary school riders is 60cm. Please do not choose jumping if you are not capable at 60cm.

All participants are required to walk the course and if not competent to cope with the specification and conditions, withdraw from the competition.

- \*Events 5, 6, 8–11 and 13 will be at judge's discretion with final competitors to complete a work out.
- \*Event 7 may include some obstacles, jump etc. and will be run at the judge's discretion.
- \*Event 12 will be a timed course with set activities.

Scoring – Points will be allocated as follows; 1<sup>st</sup> 7 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 5 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 4 points, 4<sup>th</sup> 3 points, 5<sup>th</sup> 2 points and 6<sup>th</sup> 1 point.

All Riders are to be in school uniform with light coloured jodhpurs, boots and helmets as per PCV/EA rules.

All team members must present for a compulsory gear check.

Entrants compete as individuals and if not entered in a team of 4, will be placed in a composite team by the organising committee.

Every entry must include a nominated helper. The nominated helper must perform designated duty or corresponding entry team or individuals may be eliminated. One helper must be provided per team or per entry if entering individually.

Team Managers are responsible for their own team members and are the point of contact for any enquires.

Copies of EA Membership/PCV cards and day attendance forms/payments for non PCV members must be sent with entry form – due to Covid regulations failure to provide these prior to the day will mean you can't compete.

One entry form per rider with team listed.

Conditions of Entry: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions.

- 1. Entry Fee is \$40 per entry (plus day attendance fee if required) or \$160 per team (plus day attendance fee if required)
- 2. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$20 will be deducted.
- 3. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that EA/PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
- 4. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- 5. All riders must wear complying helmets. Spot checks to ensure compliance may occur.

- 6. Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
- 7. Dogs are prohibited without exception. Elimination may occur.
- 8. No stallions, colts or rigs.
- 9. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.
- 10. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- 11. PCV Insurance policy specifically states anyone not following PCV rules may be left uninsured.
