- Review of Team Selection and Captains' policy due to the EV board before January for approval
- Difficulty in dressage team selection with 2 divisions. No ride offs permitted
- Other states are permitted two jumpiglevels. Not possible to run at states
- Concern over 2024 national championship in Queensland, should riders be permitted 3 classes for this competition.
- Code of conduct-ongoing issue with a few families. EV has Code of Conduct process but must come from a formal complaint
- Education on;line and or forums suggested for families to understand interschool rules and discipline rules
