



Summary of Business ISV Meeting 23 April 2024

Equestrian Australian Interschool Committee Update EAIC

- Addition to Eventing Team of up to 6 qualified riders per division
- Confirmation that riders must attend the opening and closing ceremonies at Nationals. Exemptions need to be defined clearly and attendance enforced
- Review of Interschool Show Horse Rules. Trial Show workouts will be used by Qld

Agenda items

State Championships

- Very positive survey responses and emails feedback so far.
- Ways of improving Show Horse and Dressage in split divisions discussed
- Two incidents requiring ambulance were well handled and fortunately outcomes for riders were not serious.
- Event Risk Plan needs clarification on procedures and clear job descriptions for parent helpers. Parents with children competing cannot also be appointed risk management duties.
- Profit if any is shared 50% Ev 25% for 2025 States, 25% ISV General -requires approval to spend from EV Board. Suggested to use money to address knowledge of rules/ welfare.

Vic Team

- Uniform for Team Vic - \$150 for cap, top and socks Costs minimum. Wear white sneakers at opening ceremony
- Up to 140 riders in team with extra Eventing offers
- ISV will sponsor the Team dinner
- Request to EV to fund team pins and jacket badges as it is a Victorian team

Events

- Still looking for others to run IS events. Possibility of ISV becoming an affiliated club with insurance to run own events. Annual insurance would cover 4 events
- VEIS does not need base registration as Interschool is unofficial. VEIS is inclusive and this would exclude some children. National interschool committee has confirmed Interschool is not a discipline and they are unofficial competitions.
- Course walks at Tintern Horse Trials organised and funded by ISV as safety priority
- Tintern 2025 date could be a problem due to Easter and Anzac Day long weekend. Options discussed to encourage all Leaderboard riders to attend e.g. deduct points.

Enforcing of Code of Conduct for parents and riders to be discussed at later meeting.
